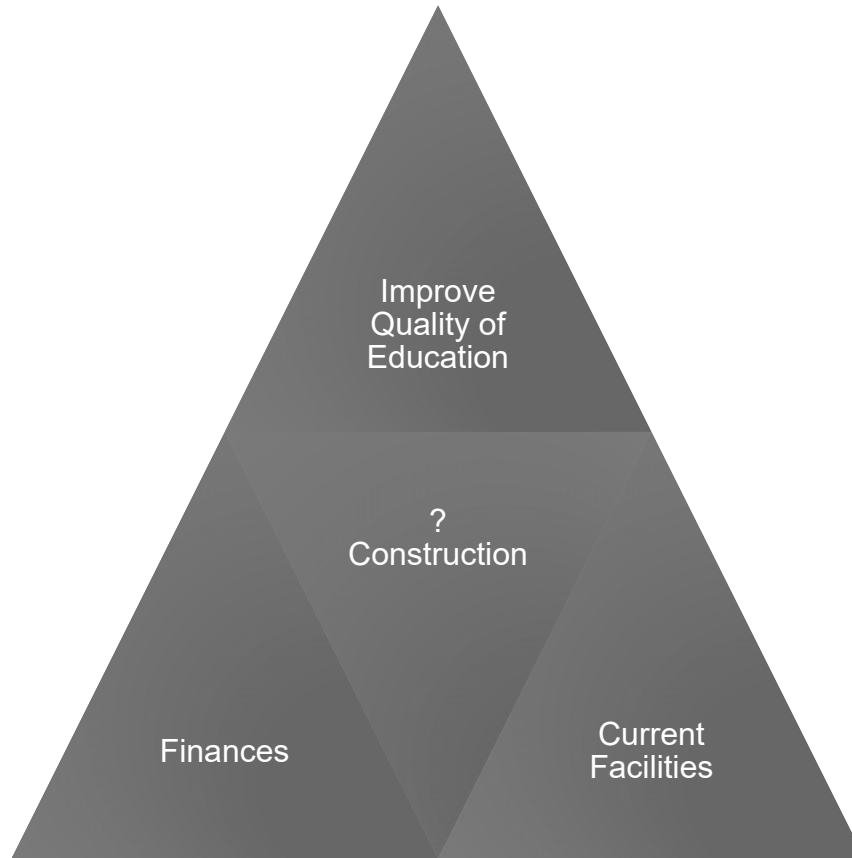

HOW DID WE GET HERE?

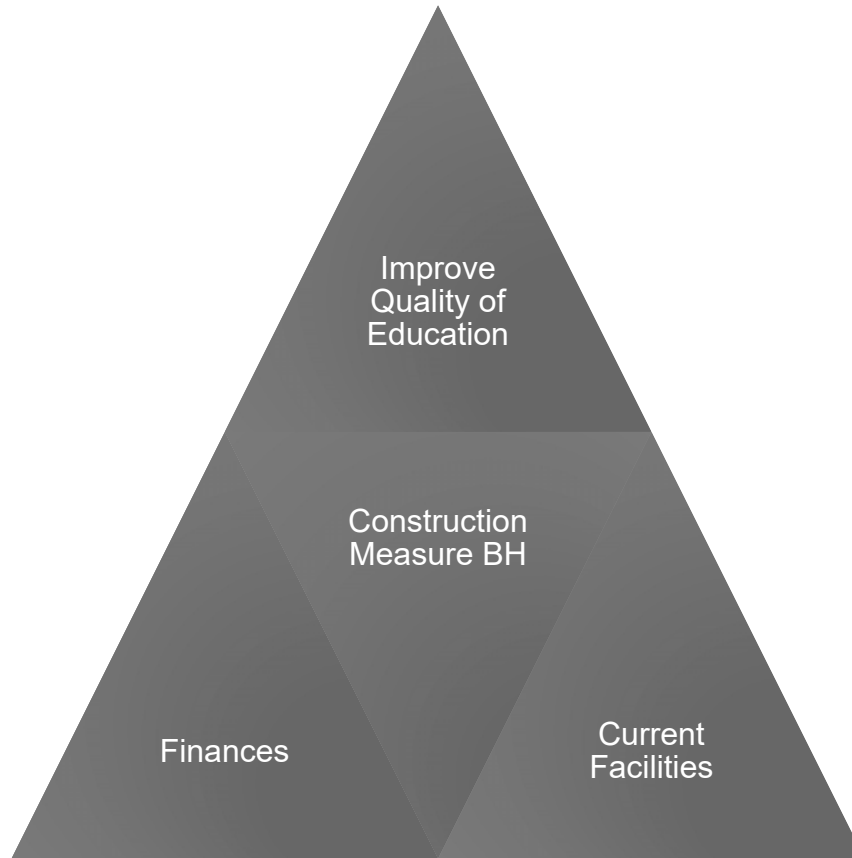
January 2018 – Future Focused School Team & Superintendent’s Cabinet made recommendations to the Board of Education for district reconfiguration.

HOW DOES A FACILITY CHANGE IMPROVE THE QUALITY OF EDUCATION?

Safety of El Rodeo students and staff during construction are a priority

Efficient 2-year construction window allows for faster project completion

Creates an opportunity to implement a district long-term plan

NEW CONSTRUCTION + RECONFIGURATION = OPPORTUNITY FOR LONG TERM PLANNING

El Rodeo K-5 students relocate to other schools for 2 years.

El Rodeo, Hawthorne & Horace Mann grades 6-8 students permanently relocate to Beverly Vista to a consolidated middle school

POSSIBILITY #1 FOR EL RODEO STUDENTS

HAWTHORNE AND HORACE MANN BECOME TK-5 SCHOOLS

Move the entire El Rodeo school families of grades K-5 students to Hawthorne.

Move the entire Beverly Vista school families of grades TK-5 to Horace Mann.

Move the entire El Rodeo, Hawthorne, Horace Mann school families of grades 6-8 to Beverly Vista.
